## 3. ENTRANCE TEST FOR PG PROGRAMMES

## M.A. English Language & Literature

Students who have not studied English as a core course in the degree programme should qualify an eligibility test conducted by the College. The Entrance Examination will be of 100 marks and of 2½ hours duration and shall test the applicants' knowledge of literatures in English, Literary aptitude, sensibility, skills of appreciation and criticism, and writing ability. In order to bring in uniformity in the standards of assessment, the candidates for the entrance examination are instructed to familiarize themselves with the following works:

- 1. William Wordsworth- "Lucy Gray"
- 2. Thomas Gray- "Elegy Written in a Country Churchyard"
- 3. Charles Lamb- "Dream Children"
- 4. Rabindranath Tagore- "The Creative Ideal" (Essay in the Creative Unity)
- 5. William Shakespeare-Romeo and Juliet
- 6. Girish Karnad- Hayavadana
- 7. Arundhati Roy- God of Small Things
- 8. William Golding –Lord of the Flies
- 9. Matrix 1 (Film)
- 10. Chemmeen (Film)

The scheme of the examination will be as follows

- 20 Objective questions of 2 marks each (on general literary concepts, devices, authors, periods etc.)
- 2 paragraph questions of 5 marks each (on concepts, themes, devices and otherfeatures of the works prescribed)
- One short essay of 10 marks (to evaluate general awareness of literature and reading).
- Two short essays of 10 marks (on concepts, themes, devices and other features of the works prescribed)
- One essay of 20 marks (Literary appreciation of a given poem/literary piece)

## Master of Social Work (MSW)

Those who are applying for MSW programme should appear for the entrance examination, Group Discussion and Personal Interview at MSW Department, St. Joseph's College,

Devagiri. All applicants should register online for admission through college website (www.devagiricollege.org).

## 6. ONLINE ADMISSION PROCESS (O.A.P)

All candidates seeking admission to PG programmes should submit application online. Online registration is compulsory for admission in every category, including management, sports and community quota. Along with the online registration form, Candidates seeking admission to management quota should submit separate application form at the management office. Those candidates seeking admission to sports quota should submit/send a copy of relevant sports documents along with printout of the online application form to The Department of Physical Education, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Devagiri. ## **Instructions for Online Registration**

- 1. Candidates are required to go through the prospectus carefully and acquaint themselves with all relevant information relating to admission before doing online registration.
- 2. Candidates are also requested to visit the official website of the college **www.devagiricollege.org** for notifications and announcements.
- 3. Candidates should register online for admission to PG programmes for the academic year 2023-24 on or before the last date stipulated in the admission schedule.
- 4. Candidates are requested to access the college website using either Mozilla Firefox or Google chrome for online registration.
- 5. For completing the registration process candidates should have the following documents ready with them
  - SSLC/Std-X Certificate
  - Degree examination mark list/ Grade card
  - Aadhaar card number
  - Candidate has to keep a soft copy of recent passport size photo (40kb- 500kb size) in .jpeg or .jpg format.
  - Relevant certificates for claiming reservation and bonus marks.
  - CAP ID of University of Calicut (If any)

- 6. The link for online registration can be accessed from the icon **PG Admission** from the module **Admission** in the home page of the college official website.
- 7. Follow the online instructions and fill in the fields carefully. Fields with \* mark are mandatory.
- 8. The applicant has to enter **his/her own email ID and mobile number** since further communications from the College will be done only to the Email ID and mobile number given in the application form.
- 9. If the candidate wants to apply for more than one PG programme, he/she has to submit separate application form and pay separate fee for each programme.
- 10. Verify the personal as well as academic details carefully before final submission.
- 11. Take a print out of filled up online application form for future reference. This printout (after the final editing, if any) should be produced at the time of admission. Applicants need not send the printout or any other document to the college except in the case of sports quota.
- 12. Applicant can edit the data entered till the last date for online registration and also during the days given for corrections after the publication of provisional rank list by using user ID and password received during the online registration process.
- 13. Applicant has to keep the ID and Password confidential.
- 14. Rank list will be published as per the schedule in the college website.
- 15. The rank list will be prepared solely on the basis of information provided by the candidates. If any discrepancy is found at the time of certificate verification, the applicant will lose the claim for admission.

#### 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Selection and admission of candidates to various PG Programmes are made in accordance with the norms laid down by the Government, the University of Calicut and the College.
- 2. The rank list of the applicants provisionally selected for admission will be published on the college website as per schedule. Complaints, if any, regarding the rank list shall be lodged through the Email ID (admissiondevagiri@gmail.com) within the scheduled time.
- 3. Applicant can edit the data entered till the last date for online registration and also during the days given for corrections after the publication of provisional rank list by using user ID and password received during the online registration process.
- 4. Applicant has to keep the ID and Password confidential.
- 5. The Schedule of interview will be published in the College website along with the final

- rank list. The candidates selected for interview will be intimated through College Website and other means.
- 6. At the time of interview the applicant should produce the **printout of the application** form generated at the time of online registration and the following certificates (original and photocopy).
  - SSLC/ Std X certificate
  - Conduct Certificate,
  - Transfer Certificate,
  - Valid Income Certificate (if applying for fee concession),
  - Two copies of recent passport size photograph,
  - Mark List of qualifying examination,
  - Original /Provisional Degree Certificate,
  - Valid Community and Nativity Certificates (in case of SC/ST and OEC students)
  - Aadhaar Card
  - Plus Two Mark List (Photocopy only)
  - Relevant certificates for claiming reservation and bonus mark (NCC, NSS, etc.)
- 7. All those who secure admission at St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Devagiri, should have the CAP ID of University of Calicut.
- 8. Candidate secured admission in community quota should produce the testimony/ letter from Parish Priest. (Only for Syro- Malabar Catholic Students)
- Applicants having secured degree from the universities outside Kerala have to produce Equivalency/Recognition Certificate from University of Calicut and Migration certificate.
- 10.If the applicant fails to report for interview at the time and the date intimated, he/ she forfeits the claim for admission.
- 11. If admission is given at the interview the applicant may get enrolled forthwith on payment of fees fixed for that programme as prescribed in the fee schedule.
- 12. The tuition fee prescribed for the whole year can be paid in full at the time of admission itself.
- 13. All admissions will be provisional subject to the verification of certificates and the approval of the University.
- 14. On securing admission, the pass certificate of the qualifying examination and other Certificates (Mark Lists, Transfer Certificates, and Conduct Certificate etc.) are to be surrendered to the College. The applicants are therefore advised to take sufficient number of true copies of the certificates and keep them duly attested for their interim use.
- 15. All those who wish to apply for fee concession, scholarships or stipend of any kind should keep with them attested true copies of mark lists, income certificates and

community certificates before submitting the same to the office at the time of admission. The pass certificate and mark list will be returned to them only on completion of the course or on obtaining Transfer Certificate.

- 16. Under no circumstances the certificates submitted to the office will be given back to the students during the period of their course.
- 17. An identity card will be given to each student on admission.

## 8. GENERAL CONDITIONS

## 1. Eligibility Criteria for Programmes

#### • M.A. Economics

BA Degree with Economics/Foreign Trade/Development Economics /Economics with Islamic Finance (Core/Main), of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 50% aggregate marks or equivalent Overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

OR

B.Sc Degree with Statistics/Mathematics (Core/Main), of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 70% aggregate marks or equivalent Overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 10%.

## • M.A. English Language & Literature

BA English Language & Literature/BA English & History/BA Functional English/BA English with Islamic History or BA/BSc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with English as Common Course (Part I), of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 45% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

For Non-BA (English) category candidates applying for M A English Language & Literature, admission will be based on an Entrance Test. A candidate should score at least 50% marks in the Entrance Test for admission in this category. Admission of such candidates will be to the one seat reserved (for each MA English Language & Literature programme) and this seat will be set apart from the General Quota.

## • M.Sc. Mathematics

B.Sc. Degree in Mathematics of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Main (Core) and at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Part III (Core and Complementary put together). In the case of

those students having a B.Sc. degree or B.Sc. Honours degree (without complementary/subsidiary papers) equivalent to the B.Sc. Mathematics Degree of the Calicut University, they only need to secure at least 50% marks in the main (core) and electives put together (if there is/are any elective paper/papers). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for a relaxation of up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

## • M.Sc. Physics

B.Sc. Degree in Physics/Applied Physics (Core/Main), of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with Mathematics as compulsory complementary, having at least 50% mark or equivalent CGPA in Part III (Core and Complementary put together) or an equivalent B.Sc. Physics Honours degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Physics core and electives (Mathematics compulsory) put together. In the case of applicants having an equivalent degree with triple main/three majors, they should have Physics and Mathematics as two mains/majors and should have minimum 50% marks or equivalent CGPA, while putting the three mains/majors together. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

## • M.Sc. Chemistry

B.Sc. Degree with Chemistry/Industrial Chemistry/Polymer Chemistry (Core/Main), with Mathematics as one of its subsidiaries/complementaries, of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 50% aggregate marks or equivalent Overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

#### • M.Sc. Botany

Bachelor degree in Botany or Plant Science, of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in the Core (Main) subject. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

## • M.Sc. Zoology

B.Sc Degree with Zoology (Main/Core) of University of Calicut, or equivalent degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Core (Part III excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

### • M.A. Malayalam with Journalism

BA Malayalam Language and Literature (Main/Core) Degree or Any degree with Malayalam as common course (Part II) or general educational component (in case of

B.Voc), of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, with at least 45% aggregate marks or equivalent Overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

#### • M.Com.

Any candidate who has passed B.Com or BBA (earlier BBS) degree of University of Calicut or recognized B.Com, BBA, BBM or BBS degree of any other University or Institutes in any states, with minimum of 45% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA is eligible for admission to the M.Com programme. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%.SC/ST candidates need to get a pass". In case of B.Com(Honours) and B.Com(Professional) and BBA(Honours), the minimum eligibility for admission is a minimum of 50% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA, for all categories of students.

## • M. Sc. Psychology

A pass in BA/ BA (Honours)/ B.Sc degree with Psychology core (main) from University of Calicut or a recognised degree with Psychology core (main), in regular mode.

#### • M. Sc. Statistics

**Under Mark System** -- At least 50% marks in Statistics/Applied Statistics (Main)/Mathematics & Statistics (Double Main)/Mathematics (Main) with Statistics as one of the subsidiaries in the B.Sc. Degree of University of Calicut or equivalent. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

Under Grade System – B.Sc. Statistics /Applied Statistics(Main) /Mathematics & Statistics (Double Main) /Mathematics (Core) with Statistics as complementary in the B.Sc. Degree of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree with Overall CGPA, at least equivalent to 50%. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

## • Master of Social Work (MSW)

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline recognised by the University of Calicut with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks/ equivalent grade. Bachelor's Degree includes other four year degree programmes like LLB, B. Tech also. Aggregate marks/grade means the total marks/grade obtained for part- I English and part III (Core & Complementary). For those disciplines, which do not have English, only main and subsidiary marks/grade will be taken into consideration. Applicants for MSW programme should appear for the entrance examination, Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

## • M. Sc. Computer Science

The candidate should have secured at least 55% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA in BSc. (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Physics or Mathematics or Statistics or Chemistry) or BCA/ B.Voc in Software Technology/ B.Voc in Software Development/ BVoc Data Science, BVoc Mathematics and AI/ BVoc IT, of University of Calicut or an equivalent degree, OR at least 55% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA in B.Tech/BE (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Electronics and Telecommunication or Electronics and Communication) recognized by University of Calicut. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

## 2. Index Mark Calculation and Bonus & Weightage

The method of calculating index mark and Bonus & weightage for PG admission will be at par with the norms of University of Calicut.
