The Institution is accredited by NAAC at 'A' Grade with 3.53 CGPA at four point scale and is also conferred with CATEGORY-1 status by UGC.

#### 5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

##### 5.1 UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS:

*(Note: The Candidate applying to any of the Undergraduate programs of the institution shall be 17 years as on 31st December of the year of admission and shall be medically fit to undergo the said programs. The candidate must fulfill the following eligibility criteria over and above the aforementioned condition.)*

##### 5.1.1 M.B.B.S. / B.D.S.

The Candidate should have:

- Obtained minimum of marks at 50th percentile in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test to M.B.B.S. course' held for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile.
- Passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in the Regulations of NMC and DCI. In respect of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes (NCL), the minimum marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for Unreserved and General-EWS Candidates. In respect of PwBD candidates as per NMC and DCI Regulations, the minimum marks in the qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (or Botany & Zoology)/Biotechnology taken together shall be 40% instead of 50%. Provided further that the students who have received education abroad must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English with 50% marks in class 12 and their equivalency determined by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as per regulations of the Medical Council of India.

##### 5.1.2 Bachelor of Physiotherapy (B.P.T.)

- A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by any Indian University or a duly constituted Board and passed in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and English.

##### 5.1.3 Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm.)

- Candidate shall have passed in any of the following examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or

**Mathematics-**

- i. Intermediate examination in Science;
- ii. The first year of the three year degree course in Science,
- iii. 10+2 examination (academic stream) in Science;
- iv. Pre degree examination;

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examination.

**5.1.4 B. Pharm (1st semester)**

- a) Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and or Biology (P.C.B /P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually.
- b) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

**5.1.5 B. Pharm. (3rd semester)**

- For lateral entry, the candidate should have passed D. Pharm. course from an Institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

**5.1.6 Auxiliary Nurse and Midwife (ANM)**

- a) Candidate shall have passed 10 + 2 in Arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health care Science - Vocational stream ONLY passing out from recognized Board.
- b) Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination conducted by National Institute of Open School.

**5.1.7 General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM)**

- a) 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
- b) 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing council.
- c) 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/Centre.
- d) Registered ANM with pass mark.

**5.1.8 B.Sc. Nursing**

- a) Minimum education: 10+2 class passed with Science stream (PCB) from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board and should have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English Core / English Elective individually and must have obtained minimum 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination.
- b) Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks.

**5.1.9 Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing:**

- The candidate should have obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) and registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council.

**5.1.10 Bachelor in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP)**

- The candidate should have passed 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination conducted by the Pre-University Board of Education of the respective State Government with Physics, Chemistry and any one of Biology/ Mathematics / Computer Science / Statistics / Electronics / Psychology with minimum of 50% marks.

**5.1.11 B.Sc. Paramedical Programs:**

- The candidate should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in science stream (with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English) conducted by conducted by the respective State/Central Government Authorities Recognized as equivalent to 10+2 Examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)

**5.1.12 Diploma Paramedical Programs:**

- The candidate should have passed the Senior Secondary Examination (10<sup>th</sup>) conducted by the respective State/Central Government Recognized Board

**5.1.13 Diploma in Dental Mechanics**

- The candidate must have passed 10+2 or two years intermediate or equivalent course thereof with science subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry and Biology from a recognized Indian University or Pre-University/Intermediate Board.

**5.1.14 Diploma in Hearing Aid Repair and Ear Mould Technology (D.H.A.R.E.M.T.)**

- Pass in 12<sup>th</sup> class with Physics or Electronics as one of the papers, or any recognized diploma in Electronics/ Electrical engineering, or any qualified dental technician course, or Certificate or Diploma from ITI in Electronics / Electrical Engineering area.
- Candidates who are <24 years on the 1st July of the year of admission

**5.2 POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMS:****5.2.1 Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) / Master of Surgery (M.S)**

- It shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'National Eligibility- Cum-Entrance Test for Postgraduate courses' held for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for General Category and 40th percentile for SC/ST/OBC.
- Candidate must possess MBBS degree or Provisional MBBS Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the NMC Act, 2019 and the repealed Indian Medical Council Act 1956 and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the NMC/ the erstwhile Medical Council of India or State Medical Council and should have completed one year of internship or are likely to complete the internship on or before the date as specified by NMC
- In the case of a foreign national, the Medical Council of India may, on payment of the prescribed fee for registration, grant temporary Registration for the duration of the postgraduate training restricted to the medical college/institution to which he is admitted for the time being exclusively for postgraduate studies; Provided further that temporary registration to such foreign national shall be subject to the condition that such person is duly registered as medical practitioner in his own country from which he has obtained his basic medical qualification and that his degree is recognized by the corresponding Medical Council or concerned authority.

**5.2.2 Master of Dental Surgery (M.D.S)**

- A candidate for admission to the Master in Dental Surgery course, must possess a recognised degree of Bachelor in Dental Surgery awarded by a university or institute in India and registered with the State Dental Council and has obtained provisional or permanent registration and has undergone compulsory rotator internship of a year in an approved/recognised dental college.
- Provided that in the case of a foreign national, the following procedure shall be followed:-
- The Council may, on payment of the prescribed fee for registration, grant temporary registration for the duration of the post-graduate training restricted to the dental college/institution to which he or she is admitted for the time being exclusively for post-graduate studies. Provided further that temporary registration to such foreign national shall be subject to the condition that such person is duly registered as medical practitioner in his/her own country from which he/she has obtained his/her basics dental qualification and that his/her degree is recognized by the corresponding state dental council or concerned authority.
- The candidate has to secure the following category-wise minimum percentile in NEET for admission to post-graduate courses held in a particular academic year.

Person with locomotory disability of lower limbs	45th Percentile
Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes	40th Percentile

### 5.2.3. Master of Physiotherapy (M.P.T.)

- The candidate should have successfully passed the Bachelor in Physiotherapy (B.P.T.) Degree Examination / B.Sc. (Physiotherapy) Degree Examination from a recognized University and should have completed a compulsory six months internship in a teaching Institute or Institution recognized by the National body of Physiotherapists.
- Candidate admitted in MPT Course must be a member of Gujarat State Council for Physiotherapy (GSCPT) and / or apply for the same immediately after admission
- It is desirable that applicants should have worked as a qualified physiotherapist for at least one year in a Hospital / Institution prior to admission to the post-graduate course.

### 5.2.4 Pharm. D.

Candidate must have passed in any of the following Examinations:

- a) 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with either Mathematics or Biology.
- b) A pass in D. Pharm. course from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.
- c) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.
- d) Provided that a student should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

### 5.2.5 Pharm. D. (PB)

- The Candidate should have passed in B.Pharm. from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

### 5.2.6 Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm.)

- The candidate shall have successfully Passed in B. Pharm. Degree examination of an Indian university established by law in India from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55 % of the maximum marks (aggregate of 4 years of B. Pharm.)
- Every student, selected for admission to post graduate pharmacy program in any PCI approved institution should have obtained registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

### 5.2.7 Master of Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing):

- The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc. Nursing /Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in INC recognized Institution.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

### 5.2.8 Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care (N.P.C.C.):

- Applicants must possess a registered B.Sc. nursing with a minimum of one year clinical experience, preferably in any critical care setting prior to enrolment.
- Must have undergone the BSC in an institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
- Must have scored not less than 55% aggregate marks in the B.Sc. program

### 5.2.9 M.Sc. in Medical Specialty

- Bachelors' degree in any streams of Science with Microbiology / biotechnology / Biochemistry / Chemistry /

Zoology / Botany / Life Sciences or B. Pharm / M.B.B.S / B.D.S. / BAMS/ BHMS/ B.U.M.S. / B.P.T from any recognized Indian university or equivalent qualification.

- Candidate should have obtained minimum 50% marks (40% for candidate belonging to reserved category) in qualifying examination.

#### 5.2.10 M.B.A. in Healthcare

- The candidate should have completed MBBS/ BDS/ BPT/ BAMS/ BHMS or Any Other Graduate Degree program from a recognized University

#### 5.2.11 Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Nutrition

- The candidate should have completed B. Sc. (Foods and Nutrition/Food Sciences/ Home Science) / MBBS/ BDS/ BPT/ BAMS/ BHMS or any other Life Science Graduate Degree program from a recognized University

#### 5.2.12 M.Sc. in Paramedical Programs

- The candidate seeking admission in a particular branch/ specialty of M.Sc. (Paramedical) Program should have completed graduation (B.Sc.) in the same branch/ specialty from a recognized Institution

## 9. ADMISSION PROCESS

### 9.1 Admission process for M.B.B.S., M.D. / M.S., D.M. / M.Ch., B.D.S., / M.D.S. Programs:

- The allotment of 100% seats of M.B.B.S., M.D. / M.S., D.M. / M.Ch., B.D.S., / M.D.S. Programs of the Institution shall be done as per the regulations laid down by the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Govt. of India in compliance of the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 23/03/2012 passed in I.A No. 16/2012 in Civil Appeal No. 1944 of 1993 - Anand S.Biji Vs State of Kerala & Others and in order to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 09/5/2017 passed in Writ Petition© No.267 of 2017 –Dar-Us-Slam Educational Trust & Ors Vs MCI & Ors
- All the aspirants of these programs shall visit the official website ([www.mcc.nic.in](http://www.mcc.nic.in)) of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), Govt. of India for regular updates.

### 9.2 Admission process for Diploma, Bachelor, Post Graduate Diploma, Post Graduate Degree, Super-specialty Programs (other than M.B.B.S., M.D./ M.S., D.M./ M.Ch., B.D.S., M.D.S.) of the Institution:

- The allotment of seats in Diploma, Bachelor, Post Graduate Diploma, Post Graduate Degree Programs (other than M.B.B.S., M.D. / M.S., D.M. / M.Ch., B.D.S., M.D.S.) of the Institution shall be on the basis of merit of *Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Common Entrance Test (SVCET- 2021)* conducted by the Institution. (For detailed Schedule & Scheme of examination of SVCET 2021, the aspirants shall visit [www.sumandeepvidyapeethdu.edu.in](http://www.sumandeepvidyapeethdu.edu.in))

#### 9.2.1 Online Application

- Candidate seeking admission into the aforementioned programs shall submit the duly filled application along with necessary enclosure in 'Online Mode' on the admission portal of [www.sumandeepvidyapeethdu.edu.in](http://www.sumandeepvidyapeethdu.edu.in). The applicable application form fees shall be paid online through the same portal.
- Application Form Fees is non refundable /non transferable under any circumstances.
- Last date of Application shall be available on the official website of the Institution.
- The Department of Central Admission shall scrutinize all the Applications received online during the specified timeline. The Incomplete application or Application without the necessary enclosures shall be rejected during Eligibility check.

**9.2.2 Entrance Examination and Declaration of Merit:**

- The detailed schedule, scheme of Examination (SVCET 2021) and declaration of its Merit shall be available on the official website of the Institution.
- In case if the number of applications are less than or equal to the intake , then the Entrance Examination shall be cancelled and the Merit will be generated on the basis of marks obtained by the applicants in the qualifying examination.
- The Merit Based seat allotment and the reporting schedule for completion of admission process will be declared on the official website of the institution.
- The Allotment of seat does not guarantee admission.

**9.2.3 Merit based Reporting for Admission:**

- Candidates who are allotted seat on the basis of merit will have to report in-person to the Department of Central Admission, SVDU within the stipulated time as per schedule published on the website.
- Failure to report as per schedule is liable for cancellation of allotted seat.

**9.2.4 Document Verification:**

- At the time of reporting to the SVDU the candidate must produce all the required documents (in ORIGINAL) as applicable to his/her category for the process of verification and ascertainment of the eligibility (For the list of documents please refer to the relevant section of this prospectus). If the candidate fails to produce any of the required documents his/her allotted seat is liable for cancellation.

**9.2.5 Submission of Legal Undertaking for future fees:**

**11. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:****11.1 For Undergraduate / Post graduate / Super specialty programs of Medical / Dental streams**

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide Order dated 09/05/2017 passed in Writ Petition (C)No.267 of 2017 – Dar-Us-Slam Educational Trust & Ors Vs MCI & Ors. had directed as follows:

*“After the second round of counselling for All India Quota seats, the students who take admission in All India Quota seats should not be allowed / permitted to vacate the seats. This would ensure that very few seats are reverted to the State Quota and also All India Quota seats are filled by students from the all India merit list only. The students who take admission and secure admission in Deemed Universities pursuant to the second round of counselling conducted by the DGHS shall not be eligible to participate in any other counselling.”*

Keeping the above directions in view, the students admitted in Undergraduate / Post graduate / Super specialty programs of Medical / Dental streams would not be permitted to resign from their admitted seat anytime after the 2nd round of Counselling for Undergraduate / Post graduate / Super specialty programs in Medical / Dental streams as the Institution is not allowed to fill up that seat and the seat remains vacant thereafter.

**11.2 For other Programs of the Institution**

The student admitted in all the programs of the Institution, other than Undergraduate / Post graduate / Super specialty programs of Medical / Dental streams, may cancel their admission up to the 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission for the said program. The cancellation of admission after this period is not permitted by the Institution as the seat remains vacant thereafter.

**12. REFUND/RECOVERY OF EDUCATIONAL FEES:**

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he/she is enrolled, the Institution shall follow the following system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he/she is enrolled, the Institution shall follow the following system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, <b>after</b> formally-notified last date of admission
5	00% #	More than 30 days <b>after</b> formally-notified last date of admission

#### NOTE:

- \*Caution money / Security deposit, which are not part of the fees chargeable, shall be refunded in full.
- In case of (1) in the table above, the Institution shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

- Fees shall be refunded by all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen working days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.
- In case of point (5<sup>#</sup>) in the table above, if the student leaves the course or in the event of cancellation of his / her admission, due to any reason whatsoever, anytime after the 30 days of formally - notified last date of admission, the student is liable for payment of the fees for the remaining period of complete tenure of his/her program of study, to the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Deemed to University as the seat remains vacant thereafter. In that event, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth has all the rights to recover the payment of the fees for the remaining period of complete tenure of his/her program of study, by redeeming unconditional bank guarantee / Un-dated cheques submitted by the student at the time of admission or through any other appropriate legal procedure against the student/parent/guardian for the recovery of entire outstanding amount against him/her.


