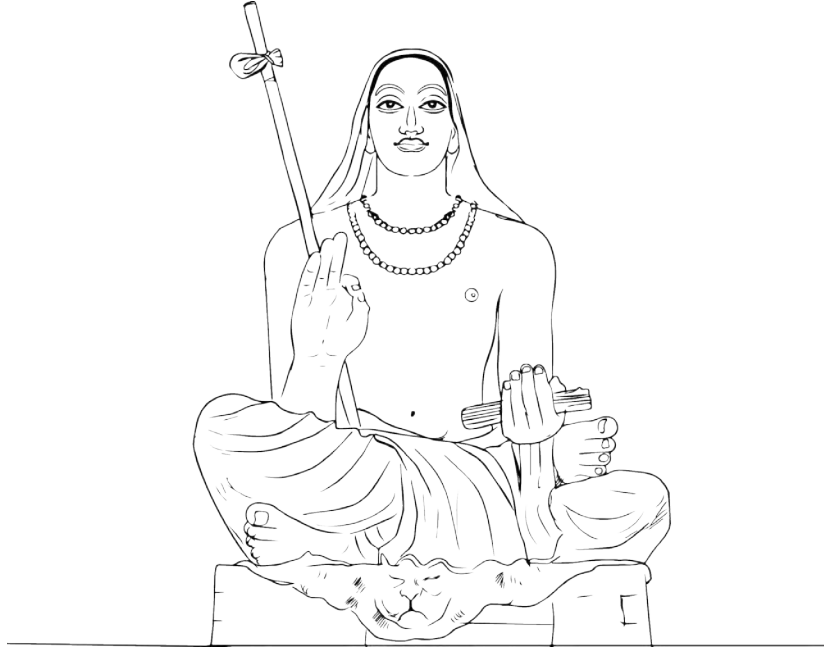

University Headquarters, Kalady

The University Headquarters is at Kalady, the birth place of Sree Sankaracharya, the propounder of Advaita Vedanta. This historic town, flanked by the Periyar (Purna) river, is an important site of reverence in south India. Tucked between the mighty Sahyadri mountain ranges and the western coast, the rural landscape of Kalady is famous for the cultivation of spices like pepper and nutmeg. The University headquarters also lies in close proximity to the famous St. Thomas shrine in Malayattoor which attracts thousands of pilgrims and tourists every year.

Kalady, despite being a quaint small village, is well-connected to the urban hub of Ernakulam. The Cochin International Airport is 6 kms away from the University. This humble yet effervescent suburban locale is an abode of knowledge, history, and heritage.

Regional Campuses

The University has eight regional campuses across the state located in, Payyannur, Koyilandy, Tirur, Thrissur, Thuravoor, Ettumanoor, Panmana and Thiruvananthapuram.



Why SSUS ?

SSUS is a premier institution in south India for teaching, learning and dissemination of knowledge in Sanskrit, Humanities and Social Sciences. The multi- disciplinary environment nurtures a resourceful intercourse between indigenous erudition in Sanskrit and contemporary scholarship. This dynamic intellectual milieu makes the institution unique among Sanskrit universities in the country. The presence of the Departments of Fine Arts and Performing Arts add vibrant ambience to academic pursuits. Achieving a meritorious A Grade in the first cycle of NAAC accreditation, the University proceeded to become the first in the state to update and introduce the OBTLE (Outcome Based Teaching Learning and Evaluation) system. Technological advances enhance academic engagements within the campus and extend outside. The operational LMS platform places the university on firm ground in the pandemic situation.

International School for Sree Sankara Studies draws together national and international scholarship to facilitate research and publications on the philosophy and thought of Sree Sankaracharya .

Sastrasamvardhini Centre for Traditional Learning imparts Shastraic learning, in the traditional mode, to students and faculty members of the University as well as of schools and colleges in Kerala.

Strengthening of Sanskrit Studies, envisaged under the special scheme selecting the University as the nodal agency in Kerala, promotes learning of Sanskrit in schools through provision of scholarships, specific instruction modules and competitions organised.

Sanskrit Day and Sree Sankara Annual Lectures are key annual events conducted with much participation.

Social Commitment

SSUS is always in the forefront in serving the society by effective dissemination of knowledge. In addition to scholarly exchanges, the academic Departments employ their expertise to assist the public to survive critical situations like the deluge and the pandemic.

Shastrayan : Organised as an open house event showcasing academic excellence and research of the University through exhibitions, demonstrations and performances, the programme was recognised for its wide public participation and social interest.

International Exposure

The University ensures global exposure marking its international presence through various academic exchanges. Many scholars and faculty members from SSUS have been visiting abroad for academic presentations and cultural programmes. The University also hosts scholars from other countries, offering its culturally diverse and academically unique environment.

Academic Support System and Student Services

Mentoring and Career Guidance : Faculty support to students in advisory and counsellor capacities offers guidance at personal and academic levels and enables successful scholastic progression and balanced personality development.

International Students Cell : The Cell provides information, guidance and personal assistance to attract students from abroad to the University as well as to open up international prospects to the students of the University.

Student Counselling Cell : Student's Counsellor provides counselling and personal assistance to students in distress.

Students' Services Cell : Students' Services Cell links facilities and support services to cater to the needs of students.

Career Guidance and Placement Support : The **University Employment Information and Guidance Bureau** and the **Career Guidance and Counselling Centre** function in mutual coordination to enable excellent job placements for students. In addition, the **Institute of Public Enterprises (IPE)** is committed to impart Programme specific and employment oriented professional skills to students.

Awards , Fellowships and Endowments : Several awards, fellowships and endowments instituted recognize and reward meritorious performances of students.

Matrubhasha Puraskaram : The University strongly endorses and promotes the state government's initiatives to implement Malayalam as the language of governance. The Pradeepan Pampirikunnu Memorial Matrubhasha Puraskaram instituted since 2017 and awarded to persons involved in the pursuit of promoting Malayalam strongly vouch for this.

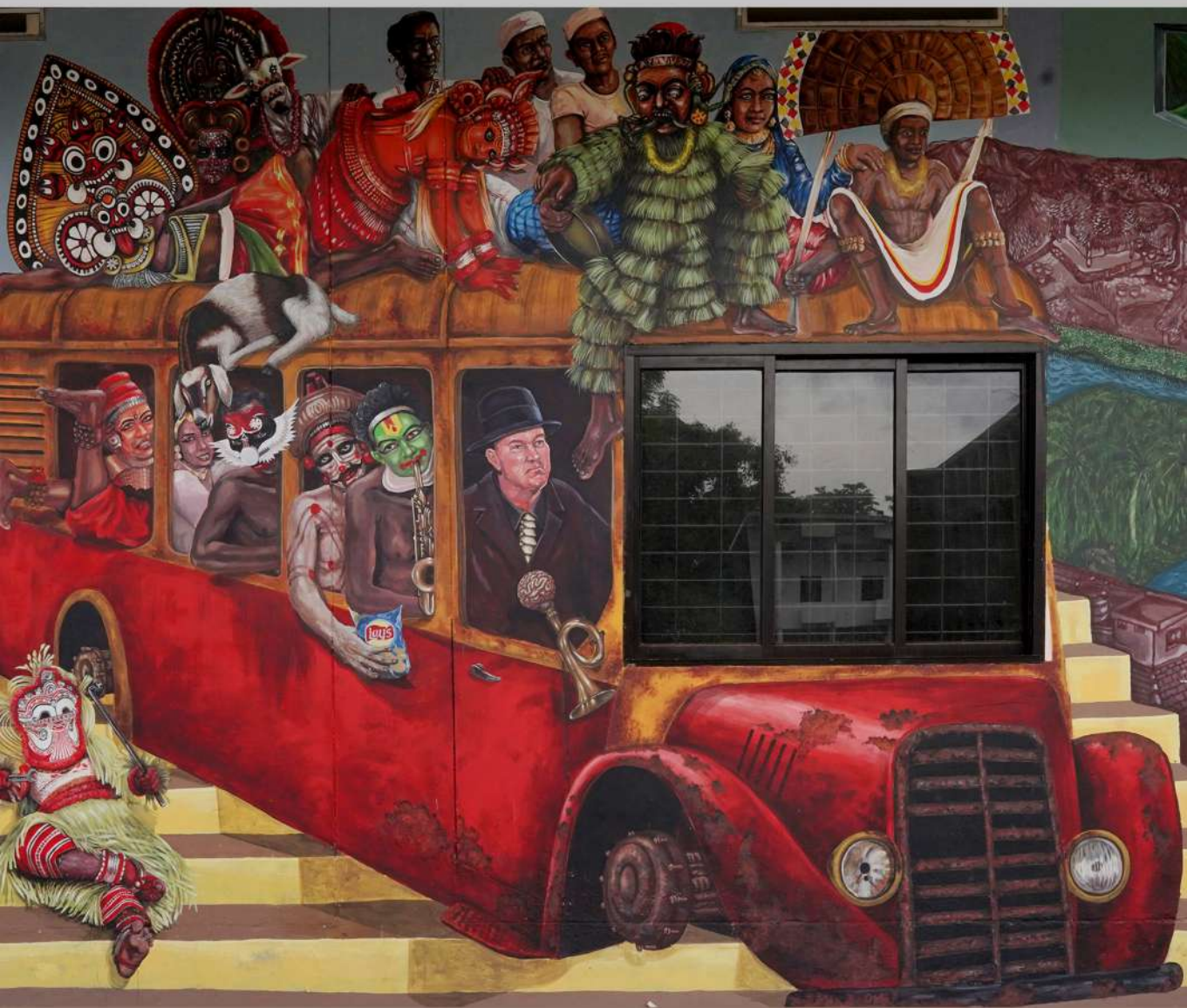
Library and Learning Resources

Saraswatham Centre for Learning, the University library, functions at the University Headquarters at Kalady and is complemented with libraries functioning in the eight regional campuses. Off-Campus Access Service is provided to faculty members and research scholars to seamlessly access the subscribed electronic resources from outside the University campus.

Manuscript Resource Conservation Centre (MRCC)

An excellent collection of manuscripts, dating back centuries, has been collected, digitally processed, preserved and curated in MRCC and is open to scholars for reference. The Manuscript Resource Centre and Manuscript Conservation Centre provide access to a wide range of rare research materials.





Attractions

Lalit Kala Art Gallery : Situated in the Utility Building and established in association with the Kerala Lalit Kala Akademi, the Art Gallery showcases the art and creative potential of students and faculty members.

Koothambalam : The structure of the Koothambalam emulates the traditional architecture of the performance spaces of Koodiyattam and is the location for Theatre and Bharatanatyam Departments.

Kanakadhara Museum : As an exhibition space for historical and cultural resources of the region, the Museum holds the promise of preserving the artefacts that the Periyar Valley yields.

Rupakalpana : The business incubator caters to the creative and innovative aspirations of students.

Amenities

Media Centre : 3000 square feet **Arts Studio** with five recording booths and an **Interactive Centre** with training facilities and computer labs.

Activity Centre : Facility for physical workouts , a **Gymnasium** and **Badminton Court** along with a **Meditation Centre**, that helps rejuvenate, are housed in the Activity Centre. Regional Centres too have facilities for sports and games.





Language Lab : Located in the Language Block, the Language Lab Manidveepam provides training for learners of Sanskrit ,Hindi, Malayalam and English to improve their LSRW skills.

Network Connectivity : Wide range of core ICT projects and industry–standard campus wide network systems are in place which include Data Centre, E- Campus facility and other ICT multi-disciplinary facilities.

University Publications Division: Sankaracharya University Press (SUP) provides the platform for dissemination of knowledge produced, through the print of research journals and books.

Utility Centre : The common Utility Building provides space for a commercial bank, Post Office, Art Gallery, Co-operative Store, Publications Division Sales Counter, etc. This building is easily accessible for the public.

Health Centre : Facilitates out-patient treatment and healthcare based on modern medicine and Ayurveda.

Accommodation Facilities : Separate hostels for students and researchers, both men and women, in addition to the Faculty Guest House and the apartments for administrative personnel provide safe and healthy accommodation on the University premises.

Sports and Cultural Festivals

Eco friendly Campus

Heralding the message of eco-friendly living, a Bird sanctuary Poorna that attracts rare birds like Night Heron, a lotus pond Thamarakkulam which links to the irrigation canal nearby, a 100 KW solar power plant generating carbon-free energy, rain harvesting devices and cycle-friendly motor-free pathways boost the green initiatives of the university. The Shantishtal, a grove of rare flora, lends beauty to the landscape of the University.







Join Us

Post Graduate Programmes:

Admission to the Post Graduate Programmes are through Common Entrance Tests. Group discussions and Aptitude Tests also form components for admission to selected Programmes. Admissions are notified in April every year.

Under Graduate Programmes:

Admissions to the Under Graduate Programmes are on the basis of grades obtained in the qualifying examinations. Apart from this, the Aptitude Tests and Proficiency Assessment decide admission to the Fine Arts Programmes. Applications are invited in the month of April every year.

Research Programmes:

Along with the successful scores in the entrance test, research proposals are discussed in the Research Committees for granting admission to PhD Programmes. Admission to the M.Phil. programme is based on an entrance test and fellowships are provided to research scholars. Admissions are notified in the month of October.

Diploma/Certificate Programmes:

Admissions to the Diploma and Certificate programmes are on the basis of the merit of the applicants.
