IV Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to M.D. / M.S. degree courses:

Candidates should have qualified in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test NEET PG- 2022 conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, New Delhi on 21.05.2022 result published on 01.06.2022.

Candidates should have obtained the minimum percentile of marks in the qualifying examination as per National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India norms.

In order to be eligible for admission to Postgraduate Course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the 'National Eligibility Cum-Entrance Test for Postgraduate courses' held for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Class, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act 2016, the minimum mark shall be at 45th percentile. One year internship should be completed on or before 31.07.2022.

NEET is mandatory for FMGs and Foreign Nationals seeking admission in Medical courses in India. For all other eligibility conditions, National Medical Commission / NBEMS website may be referred.

Counselling:

As per the PG Regulations 2000 under clause 9(A) of MCI, there shall be a common counseling for admission to all PG courses in all medical education Institutions on the basis of merit list of NEET to be conducted by the MCC of Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi.

Candidates who intend to apply for admission to M.D./M.S. degree courses for the academic year 2022-23, in Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute are advised to register themselves through online web portal of Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi i.e. www.mcc.nic.in (Medical Counseling Committee) for participating in common counselling and they are advised to periodically check the MCC website for updates viz., Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ), Schedule/re-schedule of counselling dates and its process etc.

On obtaining the online allotment order from the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi the allotted student shall report to the University office, Chettinad Academy of Research and Education and fill the application cum reporting form along with the allotment order within the due date as indicated in the allotment order and pay the entire tuition fee and other applicable fee etc.,

for the academic year 2022-23. Otherwise he/she shall forfeit his/her offer of admission to the course in the Institution without any notice and will have no right to claim the seat, in future.

Candidates provisionally allotted for admission will have to submit all required original certificates with the Institution. Therefore, candidates are advised to keep with them sufficient number of photocopies of their certificates.

The amount of fee to be deducted in case candidate resigns after counselling period / cutoff date:

Where any student applies for discontinuance, or without any application discontinues on his/her own, from the course to which he/she has been admitted to, for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/ remaining course period'.

VIII General Information

Admissions are subject to fulfillment of all the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University and statutory authorities (National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India). If it is found at a later stage, that the candidates have submitted false information / forged certificates, his/her admission will be cancelled without any notice and the same shall be final and binding.

Appearance in NEET-PG 2022 does not confer any automatic rights to secure a M.D. / M.S. admission. The selection and admission to M.D. / M.S. seats in this university is subject to fulfilling the eligibility, medical fitness and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Counseling Authorities i.e. MCC of Directorate General of Health Services, National Medical Commission, New Delhi and this university.

Candidates with provisional allotment letter are advised to submit all the necessary original documents, pay the tuition and join as early as possible and not to wait for last day of joining, considering the time required to complete admission formalities.

If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No. (For NRI Students Wire Transfer) on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process.

Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute / College / University" will not be allowed to take admission as directed by DGHS, New Delhi.

Admitted students are bound by the Rules and Regulations of this University framed from time to time in the matter of syllabus, examinations, fee structure, discipline and policy for refund of fee etc.

The University reserves the right to change any of the conditions enumerated periodically or for the purpose of complying with any of the regulations of the statutory councils.

Tuition fee and other dues payable in the subsequent academic years shall be paid by the students within the due date fixed by the Institution failing which the name of the defaulting students shall be removed from the rolls of the college after the expiry of due date.

Candidates himself / herself must be present at the time of reporting. No proxy will be allowed in any circumstances.

Note:

It is a general advisory to all students admitted in MD / MS course at Chettinad Hospital and Research institute that they do not avail any long period of leave during the course of study and try to complete the course within the stipulated period of three years. If contingency arises to break the study due to illness, maternity Leave by women students during the period of study, the study period shall be extended to the extent of leave availed. Their re-admission to the course after the break of study will be subject to condonation order issued by the University with application and remittance of the prescribed fee through the Dean CHRI.

According to Clause 13.2 of the MCI Regulations, “All the candidates joining the Post Graduate training programme shall work as ‘Full Time Residents’ during the period of training and shall attend not less than 80% (Eighty per cent) of the imparted training during each academic year including assignments, assessed full-time responsibilities and participation in all facets of the educational process.”

All disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions in this information bulletin will be referred to the Vice Chancellor, Chettinad Academy of Research and Education and the decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final and binding.

In respect of matters relating to or arising out of this information bulletin, the jurisdiction shall be at Chennai alone.

Tamil Nadu Medical Council directives (as per letter dated 19.12.2019):

Candidates from other states who are pursuing post graduate courses in Tamilnadu and Pondicherry have to register themselves in the Tamil Nadu Medical Council within 3 months of admission.

Penalty clause: To impose a penalty that Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) would be levied as fine to the candidates of other states who studying PG courses in Tamilnadu and Pondicherry if not registered within the prescribed time (3 months).

The penalty for such candidates for registering at the end of the course would be Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only).

IX Ragging in any form is prohibited in the University Campus

The University follows a Zero Tolerance Policy towards Ragging. Ragging in any form is a crime and a punishable offence. As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, University Grants Commission has framed “Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009” and the National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India has framed “(Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/Institutions) Regulations, 2009” and notified in the Govt. of India Gazette in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory and provides for punishment of those who abet and indulge in ragging, directly or indirectly.

Capture of left thumb prints – The left thumb prints of reporting candidates will be captured.

Capturing of digital image – Digital image of the reporting candidates will be captured and taken on record.

The candidates are informed that during the time of original certificate verification in the counselling venue or at the time of admission if it is found that a candidate has been involved in impersonation/ suppression or misrepresentation of facts and produced falsified/bogus certificates by the candidates, his / her name from the admission list will be cancelled at any stage.

XI For NRI / OCI / PIO / Foreign National Candidates

The definition of NRI for admission to Deemed Universities shall be as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.08.2017 in WP No.689/2017.

Admission in MD/MS degree course under NRI quota for 2022-23 shall be based on the NEET PG 2022 qualification and shall come through DGHS counseling.

Please note that the tuition fee for NRI candidates should be remitted in US Dollar only.

Indian citizen or Overseas Citizen of India who have obtained their primary medical qualification from Medical Colleges outside India should have passed the screening test, qualified in NEET PG 2022 and Internship completion on or before 31.07.2022.

Foreign Medical Graduates are required to bring their FMGE Pass Certificate issued by NBEMS.

Registration with National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India / State Medical Council is mandatory with documentary proof.

Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) will be considered only for NRI seats and not eligible for any kind of reservation.

Candidates who fall under the category NRI as per the direction / orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case (W.P. (C) No.689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Ors.) dated 22.08.2017 are eligible for NRI category.

For NRI candidates, in addition to the above original documents:

- Relationship Affidavit (Relation of Candidate with the Sponsorer)

- Original Embassy Certificate complying the Income Tax Rules of the Sponsorer / Parents. (Certificate from the Consulate)
