The School of Law at MIT-WPU is a top law institute in India, offering LL.B., BBA LL.B. (Hons), BA LL.B. (Hons)\*\*, LL.M. and PhD programmes. The school focuses on fostering learning, discovery, research, and a deep understanding of the legal system and the litigation process in India. The curriculum combines theoretical coursework with practical experiences such as live projects, skill-based certifications, interactive sessions, classroom presentations, and internships to help students develop critical, analytical, and strategic thinking skills. The academics includes a variety of activities, such as Moot Court sessions, Model United Nations, and Model Parliamentary Debates, which provide an exciting and immersive learning experience for students.

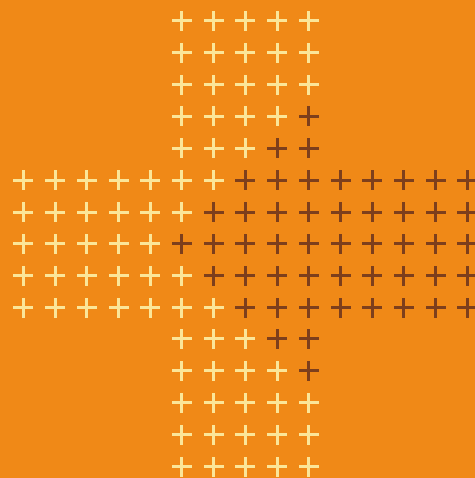

(Bachelor of Laws)

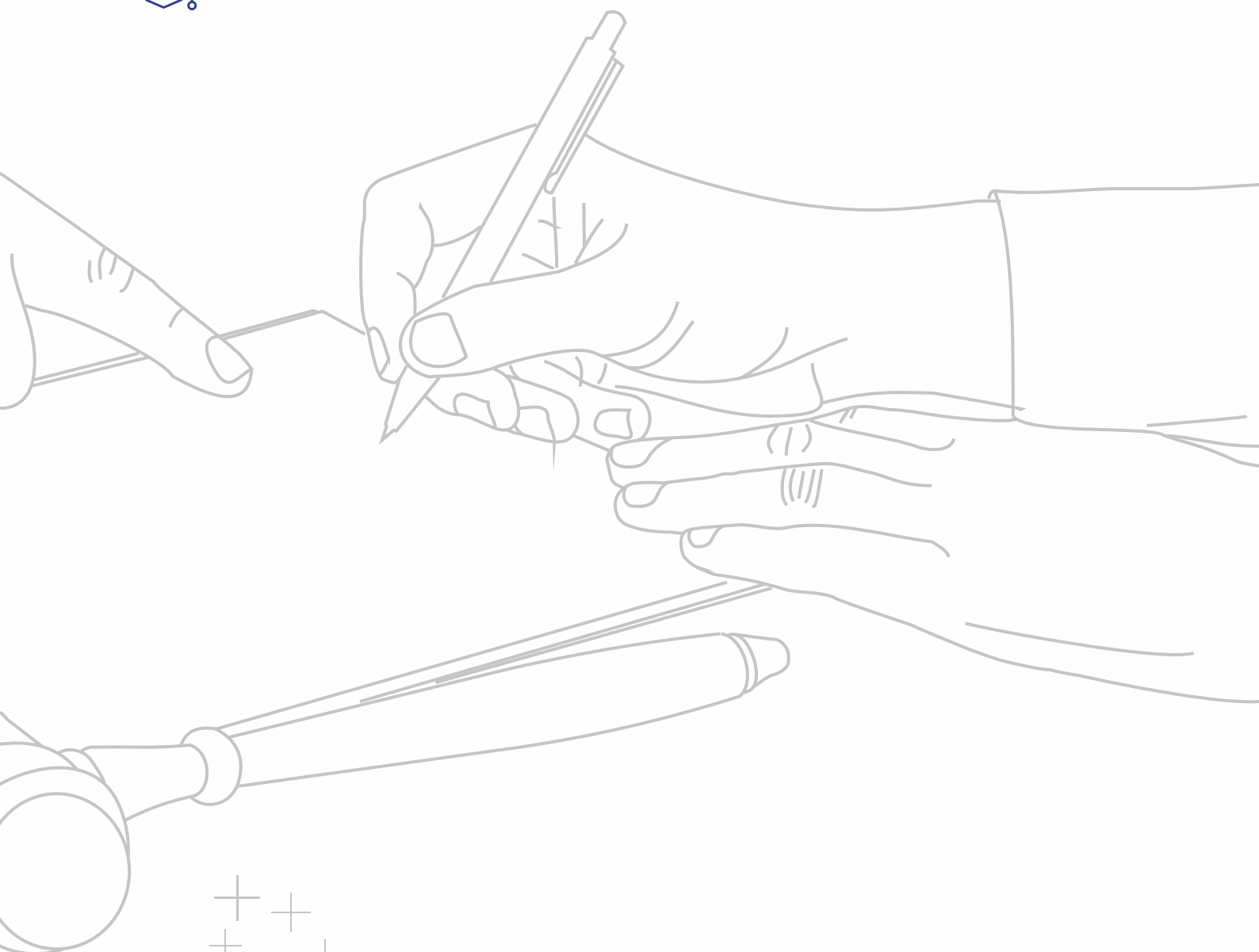

(Bachelor of Laws) is a three-year programme that provides students with a thorough understanding of the legal system, including business laws, intellectual property rights, alternative dispute resolution, and the Indian Constitution. Students gain insight into various acts and laws through seminars with academicians, industry experts, and practicing lawyers. The School of Law has a dedicated Employability, Placement, and Career Advancement Cell to help students secure placements and other career opportunities as budding lawyers.

# BBA LL.B. (Hons)

The BBA LL.B. (Hons) is a five-year comprehensive programme that combines the study of management with law. The programme provides practical training in law and a strong foundation in management, finance, marketing, and human resources. This combination prepares students for successful careers in business and litigation. During the final semester, students have regular interactions with management and litigation experts, participate in moot court exercises, and complete internships.

# **BA LL.B.** **(Hons)\*\***

The BA LL.B. (Hons)\*\* is a five-year programme that combines the study of humanities subjects such as sociology, history, political science, economics, psychology, and more with the study of law. This programme allows students to understand the larger societal context in which the legal system functions, and the curriculum is designed to meet the needs of the modern industry and prepare students for competitive exams. The School of Law has a dedicated internship and placement cell that helps students find internships and other opportunities.

LL.M.



The LL.M. programme at the School of Law aims to develop strong legal research skills among the students and the ability to apply key concepts of substantive and procedural law to specific situations. Through a comprehensive study of society, laws, and judicial procedures, students learn to analyse and solve legal problems intensely through logical reasoning. The programme also teaches the theories and practices of legislative enactment and interpretation, and trains students to apply these skills in simulated court sessions. Students have the option to specialise in one of four areas: constitutional law, criminal law, international law & human rights, or business law.

# International Symposium on Law and Peace

The symposium is a non-political and non-aligned forum for judges, lawyers, jurists, adjudicators, legal advisors, mediators, academicians, policy makers, social observers, industry professionals, young people, and the general public to meet, exchange perspectives, and share best practices on promoting ethical and spirited leadership and sustainable peace and development processes through law and justice.







# Learning beyond Classroom

## **Legal Aid Committee**

The Legal Aid Committee at MIT-WPU School of Law, seeks to provide free legal aid and free legal education to the people who cannot afford it.

## **The Centre of Constitutional Law and Public Policy**

The Centre of Constitutional Law and Public Policy of MIT-WPU is to foster research in contemporary issues and provide opportunities to discuss issues such as free speech, religious disputes, same-sex marriage, criminal justice, etc.

## **Moot Court**

Mooting is the written and oral presentation of a legal issue or problem against an opposing counsel and before the judge. It involves drafting memorials or memoranda and participating in verbal arguments. The law students are trained before presenting a case at the Moot Court about mannerism of the court. They are taught about maintaining the decorum of court.

Moot Court is an important component of the curriculum of the various programmes at MIT-WPU School of Law. The Moot Court Cell is developed to foster the interest of students in the activity of mooting and facilitate the students in understanding the core of legal research, which will help them to acquire the skills needed to solve eccentric legal problems and acquire the stronghold over contemporary legal issues and development.

# Eligibility and Selection Process

## **BBA LL.B. (Hons) and BA LL.B. (Hons)\*\***

- Minimum 55% aggregate score in 10+2/Class 12th with English subject or in equivalent examination (at least 50% marks, in case of Backward class category candidate belonging to Maharashtra State only)
- The selection process for the programme is based on MIT-WPU CET 2023 / LSAT / CLAT / MH CET & Personal Interview score.  
\*Note: MIT-WPU retains the right to make changes to any published schedule.

## **LL.B. Programme:**

- Minimum 55% aggregate score in 3/4 years graduation or equivalent from Govt. Approved Institution (at least 50% marks, in case of Reserved class category candidate belonging to Maharashtra State only)

- The selection process for the programmes is based on MIT-WPU CET 2023 / LSAT / CLAT / PERA / AILET / MH CET Law Score & Personal Interview score.  
\*Note: MIT-WPU retains the right to make changes to any published schedule.

## **LL.M. Programme**

- 3/4-Year Graduation or above in the stream of law or social science with minimum 50% aggregate score (at least 45% marks, in case of Reserved class category candidate belonging to Maharashtra State only)
- The selection process for the programme is based on MIT-WPU CET 2023 Personal Interview score.  
\*Note: MIT-WPU retains the right to make changes to any published schedule.





# Scholarships

MIT-WPU awards scholarships to its meritorious students based on their academic performance in requisite National/State Level Entrance Exam scores and in the MIT-WPU CET Examination, conducted by MIT-WPU, for the academic year 2023-24. - attendance is to be maintained at a minimum of 80 percent
- there should be no disciplinary action against the student.

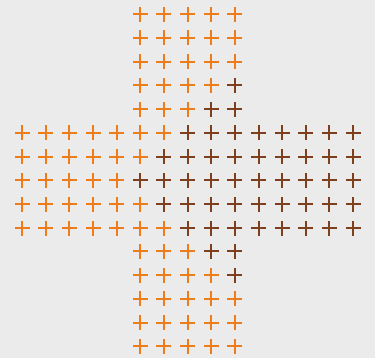

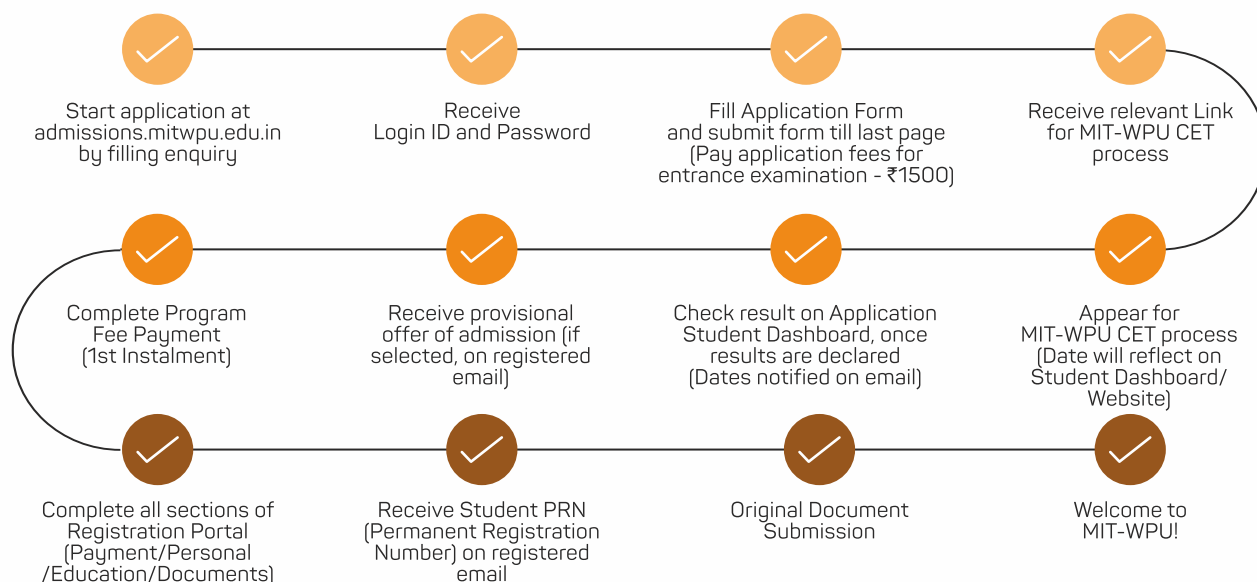
