Regulatory Norms for Admissions

B.A., LL.B. / B.B.A., LL.B. 5 Years Integrated Degree Course. & LL.B. 3 Years Degree Course.

Eligibility Criteria:

Selection will be based on merit cum reservation basis, An applicant who has successfully completed regular Pre-University Course or Senior Secondary School Course with (10+2 Pattern) from an Institution recognized by the Central or State Government in India or any equivalent Institution from a Foreign University recognized by the Government of that country and also recognized in India may apply for 5 years integrated degree course in law leading to the conferment of Degree in B.A., LL.B. / B.B.A., LL.B. upon successful completion of the regular programme conducted under these regulation. An applicant who has successfully graduated in any discipline with a minimum of 45% from any University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent National Institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence may apply for 3 years degree course in law leading to the conferment of Degree in LL.B. upon successful completion of the regular programme conducted under these regulation.

Curriculum:

Candidates seeking admission to B.A., LL.B. / B.B.A., LL.B. 5 Years Integrated Degree Course will have 10 semesters course spread over a period of 5 years and LL.B. 3 Years Degree Course will have 6 semesters course spread over a period of 3 years. *The Applicant who passed the prescribed qualifying Examination from recognized boards of Examination that are situated outside of Karnataka or in foreigner Country shall compulsory obtain the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE before taking admission.

Percentage of Marks:

- Minimum 45% marks in qualifying examination (General Merit).
- Minimum 42% marks in qualifying examination (OBC Category).
- Minimum 40% marks in qualifying examination (SC, ST & Cat-I).

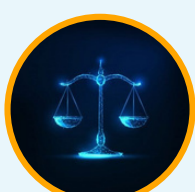

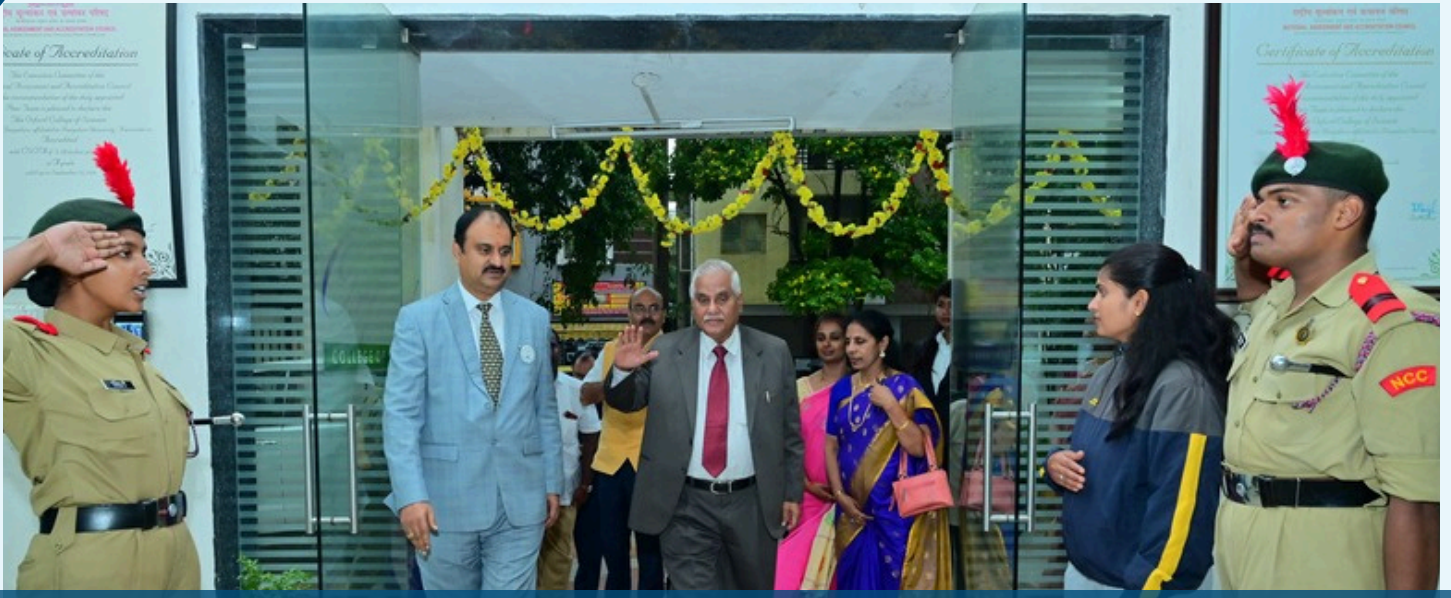
INTRODUCTION
