FROM THE DESK OF THE REGISTRAR



Aliah University – a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal – came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5 April 2008. The University started its glorious journey from the 2008-09 academic session with the aim to build a symbiosis of heritage and modernization and through the participation and co-operation of people irrespective of race, caste, creed, or class. This University plays a leading role in the advancement of higher education especially of the minority communities who have for various historical reasons remained socially and educationally backward. The spirit of Aliah University engraved in its motto, 'Advancement of Education and Culture' is very significant, suggestive, and breaks all the barriers which come to acquiring modern and scientific education. It urges its students to an unabating quest for acquiring higher education along with creating sensible human beings with embedded cultural and ethical values.

The Aliah University has approvals from statutory bodies like the University Grants Commission (UGC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the West Bengal Nursing Council (WBNC). The University has three (3) campuses and through its 23 academic departments it offer 50 academic programmes. The present intake capacity is 1110 students at the postgraduate level and 1480 students at the

undergraduate level. Research programmes in various disciplines are also being pursued actively and there is immense scope for progress in the near future. So far over 460 research scholars have enrolled in various subjects. Apart from offering various academic programmes in Science, Engineering, Language, Social Sciences, Law, Nursing, and B.Ed., we also offer Value Added Courses (VACs) to enhance the employability of our students.

Apart from the regular process of teaching, learning and research, Aliah University, aims to instil the dynamism of its glorious heritage of the past among all its students and scholars, so that they can successfully cope with the critical needs and challenges of the present and contribute to the future advancement of science, technology, and human civilization.

The Institute's Innovation Council (IIC), works towards the promotion of innovation, entrepreneurship, start-up and incubation at Aliah University. Its primary aim is to boost local home-bred entrepreneurial and start-up ventures from among the students, faculties and other members of the ambient population. Last year we have received a couple of projects funded by the Central as well as the State Government. Such projects help us to strengthen its drive in the domain of social entrepreneurship. The University has established strong academic linkages with various national and international institutions like the University of Ulster (otherwise known as Ulster University) ("Ulster"), United Kingdom, Edunet Foundation, Ardent Computech Pvt. Ltd., etc. Academicians from a large number of universities and institutions of national and international repute visit and participate in various academic programmes at Aliah University.

The Training and Placement Cell has introduced the “Communicative English and Student Development Programme” for B. Tech., MBA, MSc., and MCA students. A programme on “Elementary English for Adult Learners” was also introduced for Theology and Arabic students. As a step towards academic and industrial partnership, Aliah University has signed MOUs with many renowned organizations e.g. National Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (NSIC), KRACKiN Skill X, Edunet Foundation, Ardent Computech Private Limited, and BASSETTI ITES PRIVATE LIMITED. To enhance employability, and core competencies among students, experts from industry and professional organizations are invited for grooming, up-skilling, and soft skill development of students from 3rd year and final year batches. The NCC of the University under 31 Bengal Battalion, Kol- 'B', Coy-2, Fort William is very active. Last year one of our NCC cadets has been placed in the Indian Army's Technical Section.

Aliah University is a network institute of the Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS) under the Indian

Space Research Organisation, Department of Space, Govt. of India, outreach network. The name of our University is included in the online application form for IIRS Outreach Programme and conducting live & Interactive courses at our Institute/ Organization. Currently, our University is listed as one of the nodal centres to conduct online courses offered by ITRS-ISRO Dehradun.

We, at Aliah University, endeavour to inculcate competency, creativity, and compassion in every student to work for the advancement of the educationally backward classes and marginalized sections of society. The University believes in cultural pluralism and unity in diversity for which our country is always recognized everywhere with deep respect.

This year (2023), Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2023) will be conducted in a single phase for all UG and PG programmes. Admission in all UG programmes (except 2-Year B.Ed.) and 5-Year integrated MBA (BBA-MBA) programme will be taken solely on the basis of merit score of AUAT-2023 examination of the candidates fulfilling other minimal eligibility criteria. Like UG, admission in all PG programmes also will be taken solely on the basis of merit score of AUAT-2023 examination of the candidates fulfilling other minimal eligibility criteria. However, admission in 2-Year B.Ed. programme will be taken through merit score calculated from the score of AUAT-2023 examination, plus academic results of the candidates fulfilling other minimal eligibility criteria.

Historical Background of Aliah University



Aliah University has a unique pre-history. A brief look at this will offer an understanding of its social and cultural importance. Its parent institution Aliah Madrasah was the first government-funded educational institution in British India, established by the British Governor-General Warren Hastings in 1780. The chief intention for establishing this institution was to educate the children of Muslim families in Arabic, Persian and Muslim Law so that they might be eligible to get jobs in different Government Departments like revenue administration and the judiciary. However, within a decade the curriculum of Aliah Madrasah had also encompassed modern subjects like arithmetic, geometry, astronomy and the natural sciences along with the more traditional branches of learning like Law, Theology, Elementary Grammar, Philosophy and Logic. In 1821, the Annual Examination of the Madrasah was held in the presence of many respectable officials and gentlemen of Calcutta. This was the first public examination held in British India. A medical class, headed by Dr Peter Breton, Professor of Medicine, was started at this Madrasah in 1826 for the first time in British India. Dr Breton was authorized to purchase a skeleton and collect medical books. An anatomical work published by John Taylor was arranged to be translated into Arabic. The medical class continued here till the establishment of Calcutta Medical College in 1836. However, the students of the Madrasah were allowed to study medicine at Calcutta Medical College. This speaks for the high standard of education at the Madrasah in those days. English was first introduced at Aliah Madrasah in 1826, though the number of students was quite low as Persian was still medium of administration in British India. In 1854 at the recommendation of a Committee an English school, in the name of Anglo-Persian Department, was started under the direct control of the Principal of Calcutta Madrasah. After

the Revolt of 1857, the British rulers began to have a suspicious attitude to the Muslims. There were proposals to abolish the Madrasah. However, in 1860, the Government of India, rejecting the idea of abolition, rather recommended improvement in its management. So the Madrasah continued to exist. Some reforms were introduced at the Calcutta Madrasah according to the suggestions of a committee consisting of C.H. Campbell, Commissioner of the Presidency Division, I. Sutcliff, Principal of Presidency College, and Nawab Abdul Latif, then a Deputy Magistrate. Further reforms were introduced at the recommendations of the Education Commission headed by W.W. Hunter in 1884. Nawab Abdul Latif and Justice Syed Amir Ali played a very important role in these reforms. In 1896 Elliot Hostel was founded, with funds raised out of donations from the public. In 1902 the Muslim Institute was established as a part and parcel of Calcutta Madrasah. The Principal of the Madrasah was ex-officio President and Treasurer of the Muslim Institute. Several committees and commissions were appointed in 1915, 1923, 1931, 1938-40, and 1946 for the improvement in the syllabi, curricula and all-round development of Madrasah education in Bengal, particularly of Calcutta Madrasah. After Partition in 1947, this institution again faced severe problems. According to the decision of the Separation Council, all books and manuscripts, assets and estates of the Aliah Madrasah were transferred to the Dhaka Madrasah. It was only at the initiative of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of independent India, that the institutional framework of Calcutta Madrasah was again set up and teaching restarted.

In 2001, the Government of West Bengal, under the direction of the eminent educationist and the then Governor of West Bengal and Bihar, Dr. A. R. Kidwai, formed a Madrasah Education Committee. This



Committee presented its recommendations for the continued development and future excellence of Aliah Madrasah in 2002. Finally, the over-two-hundred-year-old institution was elevated to the status of a university in 2007. Aliah University - a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal - came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5th April 2008. Classes were being held in various rented buildings at Sector I and Sector V of Salt Lake City, apart from the Heritage building at Haji Md Mohsin Square. In 2011 the Government of West Bengal led by Mamata Banerjee, the Hon'ble Chief Minister, allotted 20 acres of land at New Town and the foundation stone for the New Town Campus was laid by her on 15 December 2011. The newly-built building was inaugurated by her on 11 November 2014, National Education Day. By this time the G+ 9 building at Park Circus Campus was also completed. So, the academic and administrative activities of the university started at both these two new campuses from January 2015.

It may be observed that Aliah Madrasah from its early days imparted teaching in the traditional subject of theology, and the modern sciences, social

sciences, and humanities. To keep alive this tradition of teaching, right from the start, Aliah University has offered courses in the traditional Islamic Theology and Arabic along with subjects like English, Bengali, History and Geography and many other branches of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Botany, Microbiology, and Zoology) as well as Engineering (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics and Communications, Computer Science and Engineering), Management and Business Administration, Nursing, and Journalism & Mass Communication. Keeping in mind the requirements of the employment sector in the 21st century, right from the start, great emphasis has been put on courses in the Sciences, Engineering, Technology and Management, so that students from the minority community become eligible and can compete for jobs in various sectors. In keeping with the great stress laid by the UGC on the Semester system of education and Letter Grade process of marking, Aliah University has adopted semesterization, credit system, continuous assessment, and letter grading from its inception. All UG curricula are running under CBCS pattern as per UGC from 2019-20 and 2020-21 academic sessions, and CBCS system is also introduced in all PG programmes from 2021-22 academic session.

Aliah University has a full-fledged Training & Placement Cell (T&P Cell) which is under the supervision of a full time Training and Placement Officer (TPO) to provide placement assistance to the students. It conducts special training sessions for the students to develop soft skills and English communication skills and help them to prepare for aptitude test, group discussion and personal interview which is required for the enhancement of employability and to meet the industry requirement. The T&P Cell also provides counselling to students regarding placement opportunities and establishes

University-Industry relationship for further improvement of the students. The T&P Cell has initiated an industrial training & internship programme, in which students are encouraged to enhance their industrial exposure by capitalizing on the semester breaks and vacations. They are guided to go through training programmes of various Governments and Public-Sector Undertaking organisations. The Cell actively obtains feedback from different recruiters and conveys the same to different academic departments, which, in turn, train students accordingly, thereby increasing their employability.

The major activities of the T&P Cell include:

- I. Developing strong network between the University and the corporate world throughout India.
- II. Arranging on and off campus placement programmes.
- III. Organizing Pooled campus drive at Aliah University.
- IV. Arranging step by step training methodology to develop various employable skills including interview handling skills of the students.
- V. Employing professional trainers from reputed training agencies to train the students through Mock Interviews, Aptitude Tests, Group Discussions, Online Tests, Personality Development Tests and HR Interview.
- VI. Organizing seminars and lectures periodically by eminent personalities from both academia and industries.

One G+19 Boys' Hostel with accommodation for 627 boarders.

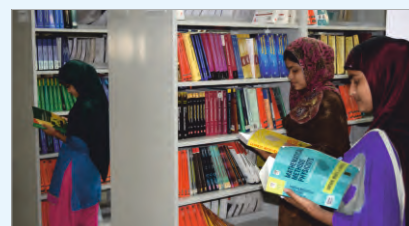
One G+13 Girls' Hostel with accommodation for 432 boarders.

Candidates, without honours or PG in the above ten method subjects, will be eligible to apply for any one of the above subjects as the first method if they have studied at least 200 marks in that subject at the graduation level with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

- Those applying in Physical Science as the method subject should have studied either Physics or Chemistry as a subject of at least 200 Marks at the Graduation level.
- Candidates having Honours/PG in Statistics/Economics shall be eligible to apply and, in this case, they shall have to take Mathematics as the method subject provided that a candidate has studied Mathematics as a subject of at least 200 Marks at the Graduation level.

ii) Notes for 2-Year B.Ed. Programme:

- Intake Capacity of Deputed candidates from recognized High Madrasah and Sr. Madrasah of West Bengal and Other University, as per Table No. 18 (Page No. 25).
- For fresher candidates, in case of Honours Graduate, the marks obtained in Honours Subject will be considered. In case of General Graduates, the total marks obtained in General/Subsidiary/Pass subjects will be considered.
- If seat(s) reserved for any particular category remains vacant, it will be filled up by other category of same method subject or may be transferred to other method subject as may be deemed fit by competent authority.

- % of marks obtained in class 10 x 0.2
- % of marks obtained in class (10+2) x 0.2

- % of marks obtained in PG x 0.3

iv) Final merit score will be calculated based on academic score and admission test score.

Upper age limit for undergraduate programmes is 22 years except for the following -

- B.A. Honours in Islamic Theology and B.A. Honours in Islamic Studies, Lateral entry into 2nd Year of B.Tech. Programmes - 25 Years.
- 4-Year B.Sc. in Nursing - 27 years.
- Minimum age limit of 17 Years as on 31st December, 2023 will be applicable only for 4-Year B.Sc. in Nursing programme.

Upper age limit for Postgraduate programmes is 25 years except for the following -

- M.A. in Islamic Theology, Islamic Studies, M.Tech. programmes - 27 years
- 2 Year B.Ed. programme - 30 years
- M.A. in Education - 32 years
- No upper age limit for LL.M.

Though the upper age limit is mentioned above, all the applicants applying for Undergraduate & Postgraduate programmes who have passed qualifying examination before 2021 are not eligible to take admission in the year 2023 except for 2-Year LL.M. programme.

Only those candidates who will complete the qualifying degree from Aliah University in the year 2023, and those who have already completed the same from Aliah University (not earlier than 2021) and have not migrated to any other institution, will be considered as internal candidates.



- For undergraduate programmes all the qualifying examinations should be from any recognized Councils/Boards/Madrasah board, such as West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Examination (WBCHSE), West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME), Central Board of Secondary Education (New Delhi) (CBSE), Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC), etc.
- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/University.
- Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defence Academy.
- Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a minimum of five subjects, or H.S. Examination Conducted by W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling.
- In 2-Year LL.M. programme specialization will be business Law.
- All the Post Graduate programmes including LL.M. programme are day programme.

AT ANY STAGE, IF ANY DISCREPANCY IS FOUND, THE ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATE WILL BE CANCELLED AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF FEES.

- Question paper of AUAT-2023 will be of 100 marks and examination duration will be of 2 Hours.
- 20% of the Questions in AUAT-2023 will on General Knowledge, General English, and Islamic History & Culture, and 80% of the Questions will be from the respective subject.
- Question paper will consist of objective type multiple choice questions (MCQs). (Except for B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communications).
- For B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, and Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication 80% of the question from relevant subject (i.e., 64 marks) will be of objective type MCQ and rest 20% of the question from relevant subject (i.e., 16 marks) will be of descriptive type.
- Questions in all papers are to be answered on a specially designed machine gradable sheet (ORS-Optical Response Sheet) using black/blue ball point pen only.
- Question paper will be in Bengali/ English.
- Question papers will not be allowed to take out from the examination hall.
- Part-I (80 Marks) Follow the next table for detail syllabi.
- Part-II (20 Marks) on General Knowledge, General English and Islamic History & culture (in the ratio of approximately 1:1:2).

Syllabus for Core Subjects:

- All B.Tech. and BCA will be comprised of Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics as per syllabi of classes XI & XII of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) and Equivalent.
- Lateral entry to the 2nd Year of B.Tech. Programmes will comprise of Engineering Mathematics, Basic Computer Science, Strength of Material, Engineering Mechanics, Environmental Engineering, Basic Electrical Technology and Basic Electronics Engineering.
- Integrated MBA (BBA - MBA) programme will be on basis of Mathematics, verbal and non-verbal reasoning, Commercial Arithmetics and elementary knowledge in concerned area.
- All UG programmes (except Arabic, Urdu, Islamic Theology and Islamic studies) will be comprised of concerned subject as per syllabi of classes XI & XII of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) and Equivalent.
- Nursing Programme will comprise of Biology, Chemistry & Physics as per syllabus of JENPARH/JENPAUH, West Bengal.
- Honours in Arabic and Urdu comprise as per Arabic and Urdu syllabi of H.S. or equivalent examination.
- B.A. Hons. in Islamic Theology and Islamic Studies comprise as per syllabi of Fazil according to West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME).
- B.Sc. (Hons.) in Statistics as per syllabus of classes XI & XII of Mathematics of H.S. of WBCHSE
- Masters programmes excluding MJMC will be on concerned subject.
- MJMC will be on English, Concept of language and Literature, Fundamentals of Journalism and Mass Communication having its role as forth pillar of Indian Democracy, Sports and Cinema.
- MCA programme will be comprised of Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, Data Interpretation, Problem Solving Questions, Discrete Quantitative Analysis and Basic Mathematics.
- For LL.M. Programme - based on LL.B. programme of recognised University.
- For B.Ed. Programme syllabus will be comprised of Reasoning, Teaching aptitude, General Knowledge, and Current Affairs.

Syllabus for General English, General Knowledge, Islamic History & Culture:

- General English: Basic knowledge of vocabularies, grammar and comprehension of 10+2 level.
- General knowledge: This will be comprised of History (Medieval and Modern India), Geography, Political Science, General Science and Current Affairs.
- Islamic History & Culture: This will be based on 10+2 level.



Admission Procedure in details:

Selection and admission of the candidates in Aliah University is based on the following steps.

ONLINE APPLICATION



- All candidates willing to take admission in Aliah University must apply through online mode of application only. Link and detailed instruction will be given in the AliahUniversity website (www.aliah.ac.in) on the scheduled date.
- Candidates are advised to follow the application guidelines thoroughly before applying online.
- After submitting the online application successfully, a confirmation sheet/application submission form, bearing the full application summary with the photo & signature of the candidate, will be generated by the system. Application is not complete until the confirmation sheet/application submission form is generated.
- Candidates have to download and print the confirmation sheet/application submission form and should preserve the same carefully.
- Photograph and signature must be maintained in proper pixel and aspect ratio.
- Candidates are advised to ensure the correctness of their complete mailing address, pin code, e-mail address and mobile number. Please note, that the University will not be responsible if candidates could not be reached due to incomplete or illegible address, Email Id, or mobile number.
- Select the admission test-centres in order of your preference.
- Final decision regarding allotment of the Entrance Test/Examination-Centre for AUAT-2023 will be taken by the authority.
- Request for change of Entrance Test/Examination-centre at any stage will not be entertained.

MARKS/ MARKSHEET UPLOAD



- Candidates have to upload the required Marks/ Marksheet/ Documents during online application, but the candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination they have to upload required Marks/ Marksheet/Documents as per the notification/application guidelines given in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

ADMIT CARD



- Candidates have to download and print the admit card within the stipulated time by logging in into admission portal by using his/her User ID and Password.
- Entrance Test/Examination venue and schedule will be mentioned in the admit card.
- No hardcopy admit-card will be sent to the candidates.
- The admit-card will bear the name, photograph, signature, address and category of the candidate along with name and address of the Test/Examination-centre.
- The candidates advised to carefully examine the admit card. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should inform the AUAT office immediately.

ALIAH UNIVERSITY ADMISSION TEST (AUAT-2023)



- Candidates have to appear for the Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2023) as per the Date, Time & Venue mentioned in the admit-card.
- Appearing in the examination does not guarantee for admission.
- For tentative schedule please see the table (Page No.-08).

PROVISIONAL MERIT LIST



- Provisional Merit List/ Result will be published and candidates have to download and print the Rank Card by logging in into admission portal by using his/her User Id and Password.
- A list of Successful candidates of different programmes will be displayed separately on the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Merit list will be prepared solely based on admission test score (except for 2-year B.Ed. programme).
- Separate list of successful candidates will also be prepared for the physically challenged (PC) candidates.

COUNSELLING



- Candidates having valid rank are only eligible for counselling.
- Offline Counselling: Offline Counselling will be held only for the programme codes: U21, U13 & U14.
- A general merit list will be published for U21-B.Tech. Programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present physically for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the specific programme (subject).
- A general merit list will be published for B.Sc. Honours in Mathematics and Statistics programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present physically for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the programme.
- A general merit list will be published for B.Sc. Honours in Botany/Microbiology/Zoology programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present physically for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the programme.
- E-Counselling: E-Counselling will be held only for the programme codes: U08 & P08.
- A general merit list will be published for U08 - B.A. Honours in Islamic Theology, and P08 - M.A. in Islamic Theology. E-counselling will be done to select the study centre.
- If candidates are not allotted in his/her 1st choice, we will consider his/her 2nd choice (if given by him/her and this process will continue until his/her last choice.
- The choice submitted by the candidates during application/counselling will be processed and a seat will be allotted based on merit/rank, if available.
- Taking part in Counselling process does not guarantee the admission.
- In case any candidate fails to attend the Counselling process being present physically, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- Any decision taken by the conducting authority in regard to any issue related to counselling will be deemed as final.
- The list of eligible candidates to attend the offline counselling/ e-counselling, schedule, procedure, venue and other relevant details will be made available on Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT LIST



- Provisional Allotment list will be published at the scheduled date. Candidates have to follow regularly the Aliah University website for the same (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Candidates who will be enlisted in the provisional allotment list only can pay the admission fees online.
- The allotment offered at the counselling is only a provisional allotment.
- All the available seats will be considered for allotment.

ONLINE PAYMENT FOR ADMISSION



- Candidates will be informed about the schedule of online payment for admission along with the provisional allotment list. Within that scheduled date & time candidates will have to pay the admission fee through online mode only.
- Candidates are advised to check once again the eligibility criteria for the applied programme before making payment for the admission. If any candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria, his/her admission will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.
- After paying the fees online candidates must have to take a printout of the payment receipt.
- In any case, if the candidate fails to pay the admission fee, his/her candidature will be cancelled.

6. All original Marksheets & Certificates of class X, XII and Graduation (wherever applicable).
7. Admit card of 10th level.
8. Proof of age: 10th standard admit card/10th standard certificate/birth certificate.
9. PC/PwD certificate in original (if applicable).
10. Migration certificate for Other-State candidates (UG programmes) and all PG candidates, if he/she has previously studied in any another University.
11. Transfer certificate or college leaving certificate issued by the college. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted (if applicable).
12. Character certificate to be obtained on the college letter head/pad, no other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
13. Residential proof (Voter Card/Aadhar Card)/Residential certificate from competent authority.
14. Physical Fitness certificate (only for BSc in Nursing programme): Candidates have to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format (this will be made available on Aliah University website: www.aliah.ac.in).

Candidates will be allowed to take admission into BSc in Nursing programme only if they are found physically fit to pursue the programme at Aliah University.

ALL ADMISSION WILL BE PROVISIONAL. ADMISSION THROUGH AUAT 2023 WILL STAND CANCELLED IF THE CANDIDATE FAILS TO SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AT ANY STAGE.

ALL ADMISSIONS ARE SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION OF PARTICULARS FROM THE ORIGINAL MARK SHEET/GRADE CARD AND OTHER DOCUMENTS OF THE CANDIDATE.



27.1. Physically Challenged (PC) Candidates /Person with Disability (PwD)

4 % seats are reserved for candidates belonging to the PC/PwD category, who are otherwise fit to pursue any programme. For any category of disability (viz., orthopaedic, visual, speech, and/or hearing), benefit would be given to those candidates who have at least 40 % permanent physical impairment in relation to a body part/ system/extremity/extremities/ whole body, etc.

The candidates in this category will be required to submit a certificate of impairment from the competent authority.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seat/seats from GEN category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

27.2. For Nursing programme: for disabled candidates:

5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for nursing programme.

Further, it has also been resolved by INC that a committee to be framed considering of medical officers authorized by medical board of the State Government and a Nursing Expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotor of 40% to 50%.

27.3. General:

The category of a candidate other than PC/PwD and is hereby termed as General category.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seats from PC category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

27.4. Students from Jammu & Kashmir, and Ladakh:

Students from Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh may take admission in Aliah University under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) in 2023-24, 10 supernumerary seats are available in B.Tech. Programmes with a limit of two seats per branch and 10% supernumerary seats are available in B.Sc. Nursing programme.

27.5. Students from WBJEE (For B.Tech. only):

20% of the seats in each of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates from WBJEE-2023 merit list.

27.6. Students from JELET (for lateral entry to the 2nd year of B. Tech. Programmes only):

2 seats in each of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates with valid JELET rank.

27.7. For all the Post Graduate programmes (except M.A. in Education) 80% seats will be reserved for internal candidates.

27.8. For M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication the division of seats are 50% for BA JMC/Media Science/Film Studies, 25% for Science/Engineering and 25% for Humanities/Social Sciences.

27.9. The seats reserved for internal candidates may be filled from the list of external candidates if the list of internal candidates exhaust, and vice-versa.

28. MERIT SCORE CALCULATION

Merit calculation will be solely on the basis of Aliah University Admission Test - 2023 score, except for 2-Year B.Ed. programme.

For B.Ed. programme, Final merit score will be calculated based on Aliah University Admission Test - 2023 score, and academic score.

29. ENTRANCE TEST CENTRES

Probable Aliah University Admission Test - 2023 Venues:

- AUAT-2023** for 4-Year B.Sc. in Nursing and 2-Year B.Ed. programme will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre (Aliah University Campus/Campuses).
- AUAT-2023** for other UG programmes will be conducted only at a few strategically located towns in West Bengal as listed below. Candidates have to choose any two centres as first and second choice.
- AUAT-2023** for all PG programmes will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre (Aliah University Campus/Campuses)
