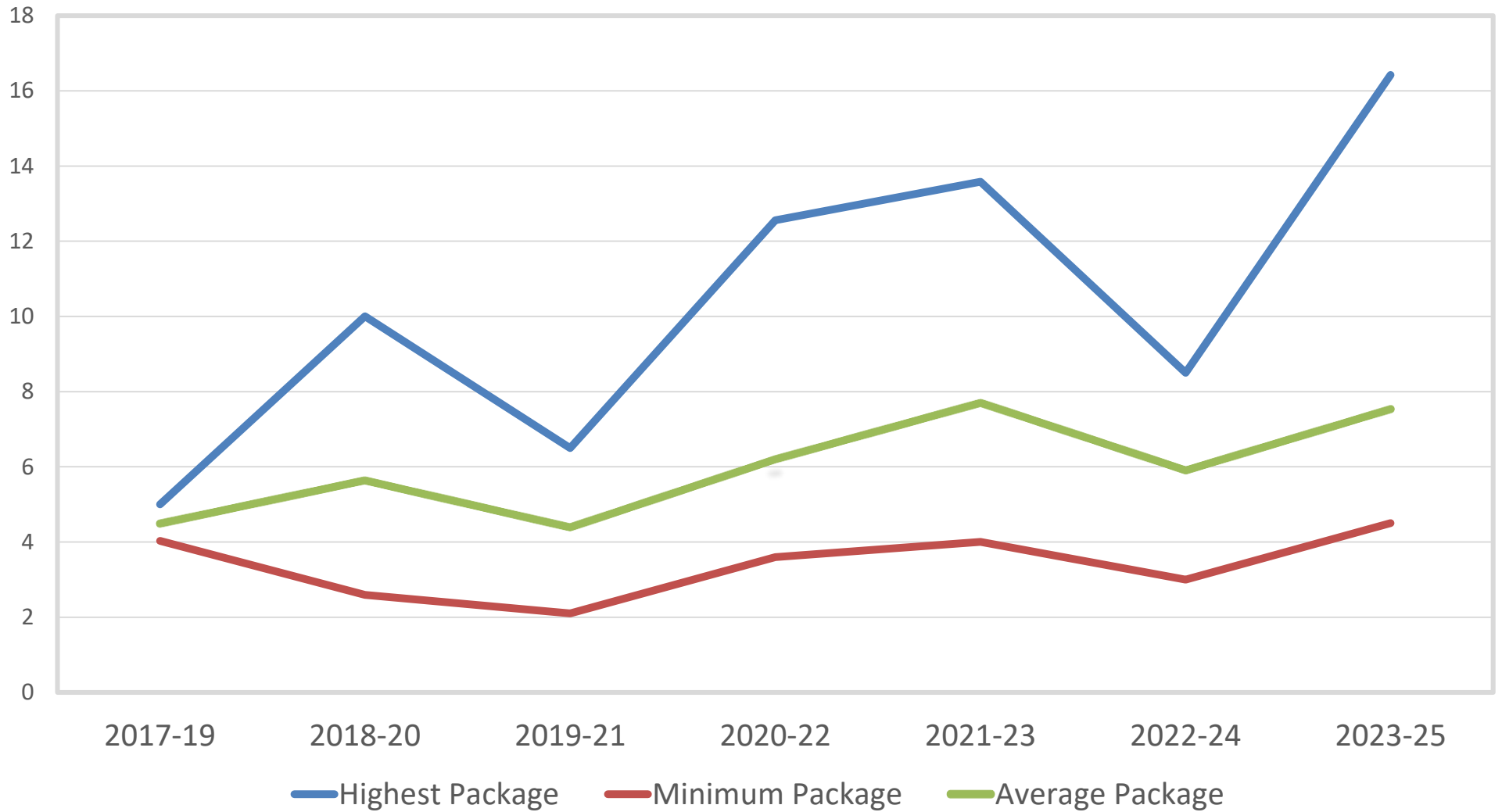

This degree must entail a minimum of three years of education after completing higher secondary schooling [Class 12 or equivalent] 10+2+3 system.
- The minimum percentage requirement in Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualification is 50% (45% for SC/ST applicants).

Waitlisted candidates will be offered admission, if seats stay vacant.

General Guidelines

1. First Round of Counselling (May 2026)

The First Round of Counselling will be held in May 2026 on the basis of merit.

2. Second Round of Counselling (For Waitlisted Candidates)

Seats remaining vacant after the First Round will be offered to candidates on the waitlist through the Second Round of Counselling.

This will be the final round of counselling for waitlisted candidates.

No Third Round of Counselling will be conducted.

3. Spot Admission Round (August 2026)

Seats remaining vacant after the Second Round of Counselling will be filled through a Spot Admission Round, scheduled in August 2026. The details of the same shall be provided on Institute website in July 2026.

The Department will conduct its own Entrance Examination on the pattern of MAT. Candidates who have not appeared in CAT or MAT will also be eligible to appear for the Institute's Entrance Examination.
